

Hello Wednesday Night Kids Families!

We have been given permission to meet once again on-campus!

WHEN AND WHERE: 3rd-5th graders will meet in ASBURY HALL in the main building from 6-7 pm. Please enter through either set of electronic doors in the main lobby and check-in at the Children's Desk. I will print tags for your child(ren) from behind the desk.

SAFETY MEASURES:

- Spaces on the floor will be set up at a safe distance from one another to keep children and adults socially distant
- We are asking that all children wear masks or face shields while attending WNK (and adults wear masks while inside at all times)
- We will have plenty of hand sanitizer and places to wash hands
- Children will only be allowed to go to the bathroom one at a time (please take your child prior to drop off as well since our time together is brief)
- Put simply, we are doing the same thing we would be doing if we were meeting outside: sitting apart, keeping distant and wearing masks.

FOOD & DRINK: The church will not provide any food or drinks at this time. Now that we are meeting inside, we ask that children plan to eat/drink before or after we meet so that mouths stay covered while we are gathered inside.

WHAT WILL WE DO FOR OUR TIME TOGETHER: Now that we are able to meet on-campus, we will introduce a short Bible lesson each week with a brief video, a couple of questions for the group, and a memory verse. We still feel like our children need a relaxed way to gather and fellowship without too much of a rigid study-structure so we will still spend a good bit of our hour together playing games/doing activities that allow the kids to relax and simply enjoy being together. Children are welcome to bring their Bibles, but it is not required.
