## All Ages Adult Sunday School

### Abide - @ 1:30 pm

A bible study oriented class dedicated to Christian growth through daily scripture reading and coming together for discussion on Sunday mornings. We welcome all ages who enjoy conversation and fellowship with others striving to become closer to God.
